2014 Fishing School

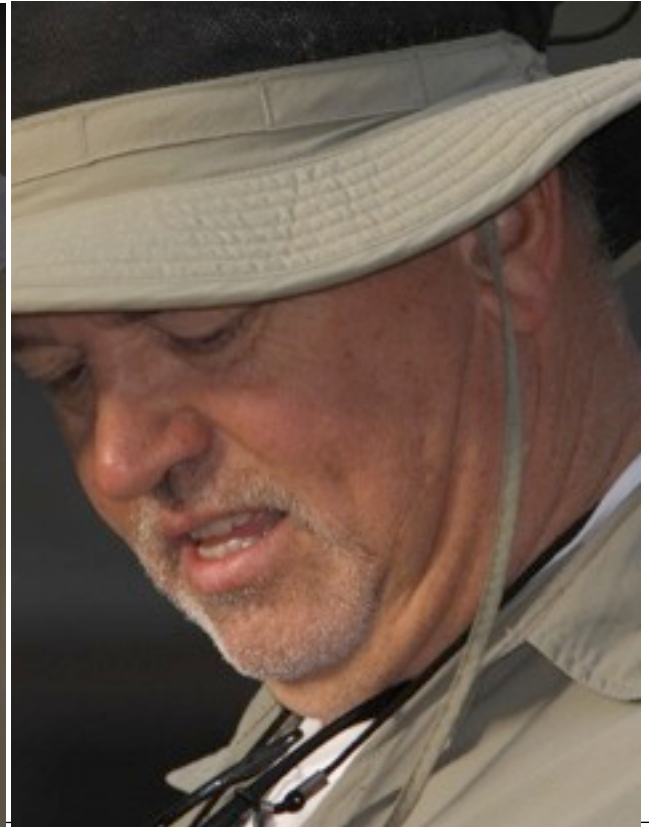
